## **2 Days CITB Temporary Works Co-ordinator**

### Introduction

This training course will enable delegates to gain an understanding of Temporary Works Coordinator's role in compliance with BS5975

## Who should attend?

This course is for those on site with responsibility for managing all forms of temporary works. It is designed to give confidence to senior management and those who engage with contractors, that candidates have reached an assessed standard of knowledge.

### **Course Aims**

Successful candidates will gain knowledge and skills in:

- Understanding the need for, and the duties of, a TWC
- Understanding the roles of others
- Understanding BS5975, the code of best practice for temporary structures on building sites
- Statutory aspects of temporary works
- Risk assessments and method statements
- Management of the temporary works process.

- Understand how to plan and manage temporary works
- Understand how to implement a temporary works procedure and checks
- Have improved awareness of temporary works and the responsibilities they may encounter
