# **FACT SHEET**

## Health and Safety Training for Senior Decision Makers - 1/2 Day

The course is intended to develop an awareness of the moral, financial and legal implications of Health and Safety in the workplace.

#### For whom the course is intended

All senior personnel and "Policy Makers" who have a health and safety responsibility within their organisation

## **Objectives**

- Understand the main aims of current health and safety legislation.
- Understand how health and safety is a line management function.
- Recognize how the statutory requirements impose upon the organisation the requirements for documentation and procedures.
- Understand and appreciate the shift to a non-prescriptive approach to legislation, based on risk assessment.
- Understand the requirement to appoint competent health and safety assistance.
- Understand and recognize the shift towards a more forceful approach to enforcement of legislation by the HSE and the implications of such an approach.
