IPAF – MOBILE ELEVATING WORK PLATFORMS - 1 day

Introduction:

This course of training is aimed at personnel who are required to use a MEWP in the course of their work. The course will cover the 'type/s' of platform the customer specified at the time of booking. Successful delegates will be issued with the nationally recognised IPAF 'Competent Operators' ID card and certificate.

Participants: Dictated by the machine types needed, but generally 6 operators for 1 single type of machine, (e.g. Boom), or 4 operators if 2 types of machine are required, (e.g. Boom and scissor)

Duration: 1 day

Skills and knowledge will be assessed throughout the course by the use of questions and answers, practical exercises, instructor observations and successful completion of a final IPAF test paper.

Method of Delivery

The course will consist of sessions using presentation, video, practical exercises, demonstrations, discussion opportunities, and course test paper.
